Are you struggling with food insecurity? Are you skipping meals to make ends meet? Tulane Dining Services and the Swipe Out Hunger program are here to help.

How does this program work? Students are eligible to receive three meal swipes at no cost to dine anywhere meal swipes are accepted on Tulane's campus. Swipes must be used by the end of the academic year. Swipes will be added within one business day of request.

Does this impact my financial aid? Accepting these meals will not impact your financial aid.

Can I reapply if I still have a need? Yes. Students can request additional meal swipes up to three times.

How do I apply? Go to tinyurl.com/swipeoutTU, type in your Splash Card number, and we'll do the rest.
