Delgado A.S.L.T. Biological Sciences to Tulane SoPA B.S. or B.A.

The articulation agreement between Delgado Community College (DCC) and Tulane University School of Professional Advancement (SoPA) allows students with a DCC Associate of Science, Louisiana Transfer degree in Biological Sciences to transfer to SoPA as a Junior and complete a B.A. or B.S. degree with a minimum of 60 additional credit hours. Students must meet all SoPA admissions standards and complete all SoPA degree requirements. The following tables summarize DCC/Tulane course equivalents, the SoPA distribution requirements that those courses satisfyⁱⁱ, and the remaining requirements for SoPA degrees. Note: Some SoPA degrees may require students to complete more than 60 credit hours at SoPA. Students are strongly encouraged to consult an advisor and develop an individualized plan of study.
