Summary:

The data below is taken from the LA Data Dashboard and provides the overall impact and demonstrated teaching skill of completers from 2016-17, 2017-18, and 2018-19. These data were gathered from Compass Final Evaluation Scores for the New Teachers by Louisiana Department of Education Teacher Effectiveness levels. Eighty-three percent of our teachers performed at the Effective Proficient or Highly Effective levels. We use these data to determine the quality and rigor of our program.

Note: These data represent the most up-to-date information available in the State of Louisiana; at present, the State is currently two years behind in data reporting with respect to this measure.
